Return of an highway laid out by the  
Selectmen of Frammingham in the year 1735  
viz: beginning at Southborough highway  
near to the house of Mr Daniel Mixer as  
the way is now occupied till it comes to the  
house of Ichabod Hemmway jun<sup>r</sup> thence on the  
North side of a pinetree marked, standing  
about eight rods from the Path thence on  
the South side of Mr Jonathan Morse's house,  
so straight to a small pine marked, stand-  
ing on the North side of the Old Path in  
the low land about thirty rods from said  
Morse's thence to another small pine  
marked, and so straight as the land will  
allow to Col Buckminsters Dam, thence  
as the way is used till it comes over  
the other Dam (the way is to lye two rods  
wide from the upper side of said Dam)  
thence to the Corner of the fence between  
Mr Edwd Wright and Serg<sup>y</sup> Fredway, thence  
southerly to a great Black Oak. Tree marked  
standing in said Wright's field, thence  
to the line between Col Buckminster and  
said Wright thence as that line runs  
till it comes to the path leading from  
said Wrights to the Meeting house thence  
as the way is occupied to the Road lead-  
ing from Mr Fredways to said Meeting  
house
