


PLAT OF

SECTION 1. Section 3774 of Ballinger's Annotated Codes and Statutes of Washington be amended to read as follows: Sec. 3774. Such petition must be accompanied by a bond in the penal sum of three hundred dollars payable to the county executed by one or more of such petitioners as principal or principals with two or more sureties, and conditioned that the petitioners will pay into the county treasury the amount of all costs and expenses incurred in examining and surveying the proposed road and in the proceeding, in case the road shall not be established, or in case the application is for the purpose of changing the road for the benefit of the land owner or owners, and no such change shall be made until such cost bill has been paid and to road graded. When the cost is assessed against the principal petitioner the clerk of the board of county commissioners shall file the cost bill with the county treasurer who shall proceed to collect the same. The board may require that waivers for the right-of-way be secured by the principal petitioner, before an examination or survey is ordered, said petition, bond and waiver shall be filed with the clerk of the board of county commissioners.

I, the undersigned, County Surveyor of the County of Cowlitz and State of Washington, duly directed
by the Board of County Commissioners of said County, on the

to make an examination and if necessary a survey, of
a certain road designated in the petition of *A M Wodaeg*

and others, did on

May 14th and 15th

lay out, survey and mark the course of the road proposed in said petition, and report as follows, viz:

FIRST

That in my opinion said Road is a necessity and ought to be established and opened.

SECOND

Said road commences at a point 20 ft west of the
center of Section 25 T¹p. 6 North Range 1 West W. M.
running thence South and 20 ft from center line
of Sec 25 to North line of Sec 36. Thence in
a southerly direction across said sec 36
and terminates in Jenkins Road Near Mile No. 2.
in NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 1 T¹p. 5 N. R. 1 W. W. M.
being One Mile and 79.4 Chains in length

THIRD

I recommend that said Road be established *Forty* feet in width.

This road should stop at angle 15 mile 2 and run from there to angle No 6 Mile No 3 of Jenkins road. It would not make any more road to build and would shorten the distance to Woodland about $\frac{3}{8}$ of a mile and also improve the grade. I cannot see that it would damage the Wright tract materially. The present terminus was made in order to avoid a damage claim from Wright.

SEC. 4. That section 3777 of Ballinger's Annotated Codes and Statutes of Washington be amended to read as follows: Section 3777. When the examination or survey is completed the surveyor shall report in writing to the board of county commissioners (1) his opinion as to the necessity of the road, and whether the same ought to be established and opened; (2) the terminal points, general course and length of the road; (3) his recommendation as to the width of the proposed road; (4) the names of persons interested in lands over which the proposed road passes, who consent to the establishment of the same, and waive all claims to damages; (5) the names of all persons who refused in said lands who refuse their consent, and the amount of damages claimed by each; (6) an estimate of damages to each tract of land of non-consenting persons interested in such tract of land, and in determining such damages it shall be the duty of the surveyor to estimate the benefits and damages according to any person by reason of establishing or changing such road, and the sum estimated as benefits must be deducted from the sum estimated as damages for the amount of damages to such person or land; (7) a description of each tract of land over which such road passes, with the name and place of residence or address of the owners, lessees, claimants, or improver if known, of each of said tracts of land, and the quantity of area of land to be taken from each of said tracts; (8) the probable cost of the construction of the road, including all necessary bridges, culverts, clearing, grubbing and grading; (9) such other facts, matters and things as he may deem of importance to be known by the board of county commissioners.
