Meanders of Emma M. Whitehouse's private land claim. Emma M. Whitehouse, having duly presented her claim and proofs of 20 years adverse possession of a tract of land in sec. 17, T. 3 S., R. 3 W.; therefore in accordance with special instructions I proceed to locate and meander the claim as follows: At a point 23.36 chs. W. and 57.98 chs. N. of the N. E. cor. of sec. 20 I set a sandstone, 20 x 12 x 6 ins. 15 ins. in the ground; for beginning cor. of Emma M. Whitehouse's private land claim, marked E. M. W., Beg. Cor. on S. face; and raise a mound of stone, 2 1/2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, S. of cor. Pits impracticable. From this cor. the Sheep Spring beds S. 30° E. 100 lbs. dist. August 3^d At 9^h 10^m a.m. l.m. t., I set off 40° 34' on the lat. arc; 17° 19' N. on the decl. arc; and determine a true meridian with the solar, at the cor. described above.

Thence I run with meanders in sec. 17. Over mountainous land; descend. S. 65 1/2° E., 25.1° chs At 1.10 chs. bottom of Swenson's Hollow, course S. 80° W.; ascend through oak brush. At 7.30 chs., ridge, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W. At 17.30 chs. begin steep ascent. At 23.25 chs. bottom of Bear Gulch 5 lbs. N. of Coyote Springs. At 25.70 chs. Set a conglomerate stone, 18 x 10 x 8 ins. 11 ins. in the ground; for angle cor. marked E. M. W. on W. face; from which a maple 3 ins. diam., bears N. 86° 30' W., 13 lbs. dist., marked E. M. W., T. 3 S., R. 3 W. B.T. A maple, 4 ins. diam., bears S. 67° W., 20 lbs. dist., marked E. M. W., T. 3 S. R. 3 W. B.T. From this cor. the Upper Coyote Springs bears N. 65° W. 12 1/2 lbs. dist., the Lower Coyote Spring bears W. 2.50 chs. dist.

S. 27° 01' W., 45.83 chs As wind through oak brush. At 7.00 chs. ridge, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.; descend. At 15.00 chs. Set a conglomerate stone 18 x 13 x 6 ins. 4 ins. in the ground. for 1/2 mile cor., marked E. M. W., 1/2 M. on N. W. face; and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, N. W.
