

The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, an Order of the Secretary of the Interior has been deposited in the General Land Office, directing that a fee simple patent issue to Rose L. Moore, Carrie M. Striegel and Edward Darling, Heirs of Francis Darling, a Citizen Pottawatomie Indian, for the north half of the southeast quarter of Section thirty-two in Township nine north of Range one east of the Indian Meridian, Oklahoma, containing eighty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor-General:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said heirs and to their heirs, the land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said heirs and to their heirs and assigns forever; in accordance with the terms of said Order, to wit: To Rose L. Moore, an undivided one-third interest; to Carrie M. Striegel, an undivided one-third interest and to Edward Darling, an undivided one-third interest. The land covered by this patent is not liable for any debt contracted prior to this date, as provided by Section 5 of the Act of February 8, 1887 (24 Stat., 388,389), and the amendatory Acts of May 8, 1906 (34 Stat.,182), and June 21, 1906 (34 Stat.,325,327).
