KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, W. J. Clemans and Edith M. Clemans, his wife, and Mark T. Clemans & bachelors, and Earle G. Clemans and Hazel H. Clemans, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar to them in hand paid pursuant to the provisions of Act of June 17, 1902, (32 Stat. 388) by, and for other consideration running from the United States of America to, the said W. J. Clemans, Edith M. Clemans and Mark T. Clemans, acknowledged whereof is hereby made by them, have granted and do hereby grant unto the said United States of America the right of way for and possession, use and control of the ditch thereon now constructed, described as follows:

That certain ditch in the Northeast Quarter (NE, 1/4) of Section Seventeen (17), Township One (1) South, Range Five (5) East, Gila and Salt River Base and Meridian, Maricopa County, Arizona, described as follows:

Beginning at a point 25.2 feet North and 12.5 feet east of the east quarter corner of Section 17, Township 1 South, Range 5 East; thence South 89° 55' West 2829.5 feet (using the South line of the Northeast quarter (NE, 1/4) of Section Seventeen (17) as a base, having a bearing of South 89° 32' West, based on a magnetic bearing of South 75° 10' West) to a point 44 feet North and 6 feet West of the center corner of Section Seventeen (17), Township One (1) South, Range Five (5) East.

Above description being of the center line of the right of way for said ditch to be conveyed. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining to the said United States of America so long as the said grantee, and its successors in control or interest shall use the same, or have occasion to use the same, for an irrigating ditch and a right of way therefor
