WITNESSETH, That in consideration of

and being in the Township of Harmony, County of Susquehanna and State
of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows: On the north by
lands now or formerly of D. C. Brooker; on the east by lands now or
formerly of George H. Bartleson and Seth Houghton; on the south by
lands of the Erie Railroad Company; and on the west by Roaring Brook
and lands now or formerly of Fred Natzel, containing about 125 acres
of land, be the same more or less.
